means do what they say but that's only if their parents are watching.



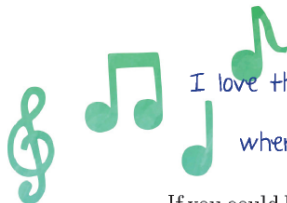
What advice would you give to someone who's about to be adopted?
